

## Reformulated Topical Medications for Management of Allergic Otitis Externa\*

<b>For inflammation</b>	Dexamethasone sodium phosphate injectable: saline 1:1 (routine) 2:1 (inflammation prone)	
<b>For <i>Malassezia</i>-prone + inflammation</b>	Dexamethasone sodium phosphate injectable: miconazole 1% 1:1 (routine) 1:2 ( <i>Malassezia</i> prone) 2:1 (inflammation prone)	
<b>Dosing guidelines</b>	Cat	0.3-0.4 mL q 12-24 hr
	Small dog (<10kg)	0.3-0.4 mL q 12-24 hr
	Medium dog (10-30kg)	0.5-0.7 mL q 12-24 hr
	Large dog (>30kg)	0.8-1.2 mL q 12-24 hr
